COVID 19 TESTING:

You will receive the date and time for your COVID 19 test, 1-3 days before you are required to be there. Our policy states that ALL patients will be required to be tested 72 hours prior to their procedure. All appointments are between 7:30am – Noon. PLEASE do not ask the SFGIE nurse for a special time or date. We are unable to accommodate this and do not have the authority to do so. The times are dictated by the lab, and as soon as we receive your appointment time, we will call you with it. Again, we cannot give you a special time. If you are unable to keep the COVID 19 test appointment, you will have to reschedule your procedure at SFGIE.

The COVID 19 test will take place at St. Francis Hospital Employee Parking Garage at 125 Woodland St., Hartford, CT. There are multiple signs on the building; **COVID 19 Testing Site**. You will look for the PROCEDURE lane. It is a drive-thru test. Please wear a mask and bring your license, cell phone and insurance card. The test is free.

DAY OF PROCEDURE:

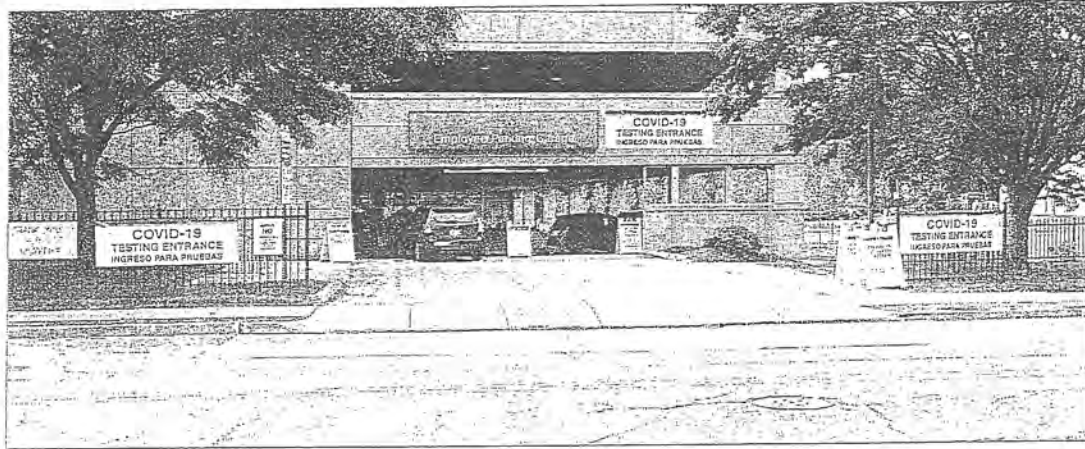
When you arrive at the facility in Windsor, please call this number from your car: 860-683-9991 x 106. If you do not reach a person, please leave a message. We are expecting you and will call you back as soon as we can. You will be asked some questions by a nurse; upon completion of these questions, you will be directed up to the 2nd floor, Suite 204. You will then be met at the LOCKED WAITING ROOM DOOR; do not knock on the door, someone will come out to get you in the hallway, your temperature will be taken, and then you will be brought into the facility to prepare for your procedure. (Please do not come into the building until you have spoken with a nurse). Please wear a mask and bring your license and insurance card.

(If you need to use a restroom and cannot wait, there are restrooms in the hallway on the 2nd floor.)

Unfortunately, your ride will not be able to come into the facility due to COVID 19 restraints. You may tell them you will be in the facility for approximately 1.5-2 hours from time of drop off. We will call your ride when you come out of the procedure room, thereby giving them ~30 minutes to come back. You will be escorted out to the car.
